Duties include, but are not limited to:



- Evaluate and assess medical status of clients
- Determines, establishes and administers overall treatment program for clients
- Diagnose, treat and control diseases and physical injuries in a clinically sensitive manner for underserved populations
- Determines clinical need for medications and prescribes as part of a treatment program
- Work with professional independence and use initiative and judgment in performing medical diagnostic and treatment services for the client population
- Provides information, consultation and assistance to other healthcare professionals
- Discusses case management practices and techniques with healthcare professionals
- Establish and maintain cooperative work relationships with clients, staff, peer groups and a varied agency and institutional representatives
- Develop therapeutic relationships with a wide variety of patients from diverse educational, social and cultural backgrounds
- Provides appropriate medical records documentation on all patients in accordance with policy

Required Documents



- State of Oregon Medical License (copy of original is fine, web document is not) License must reflect Oregon address by time of hire
- DEA Certification (copy of original is fine, web document is not) DEA must reflect Oregon address by time of hire
- Diploma (copy of original is fine, web document is not)
- CV or resume
- NPI (downloaded copy is acceptable) NPI must reflect Oregon address by time of hire
- Current BLS/CPR (copy of original is fine)
- Valid Oregon Drivers License

Successful candidate will be required to complete an Oregon Practitioner Credentialing Application, Medicare Provider and Reassignment Forms and LaneCare Credentialing packet at time of hire. Transcripts will be required at this time.
