STATUS OF OREGON'S CHILDREN 2010

CHILD HEALTH

51.0% of eighth graders reported not receiving a medical check-up or physical exam in the previous year.

14.7% of school children have access to a certified School-Based Health Center.

231 newborns were low-birthweight.

CHILD WELFARE

4,687* reports of child abuse/neglect were made in this area in 2009. 50% of these reports were assessed, and 15% were founded.

1,137 children in the county have been in foster care at least once in the past year.

35.2% of founded abuse/neglect/threat of harm referrals were related to domestic violence and 44.3% were related to substance abuse.

28.7% of children in out-of-home placement were living with relatives.

29 youth aged out of foster care.

FAMILY FINANCES & STABILITY

\$57,500 is the median family income, which is 7% lower than the state median.

4.3 per 1,000 people filed for personal bankruptcy in 2009, a 143% increase since 2006.

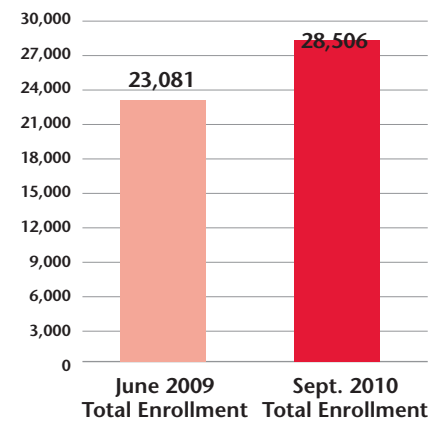
53.7% of public school children were eligible to receive free/reduced price lunches during the school year. On average, 20,063 children ate free/reduced price lunches on a given day, while 141,187 lunches were served to children during the summer.

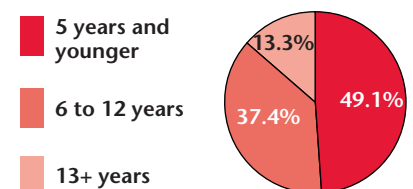
