Found an Animal?

- ▶ Look for a license to return a lost pet directly to their owner. Licensing is every pet's phone call home!
- ▶ Check for a microchip. LCAS and most local veterinarians can assist with locating a microchip.
- ▶ For assistance in returning a pet, call LCAS at 682-3647 or your local law enforcement agency's non-emergency number if LCAS is closed.
- ▶ Call LCAS and we will assist you in filling out a found pet report. If you have found a stray animal, you are required by law to report it to LCAS within 3 days.
- ▶ Check out "lost/found pet" ads and "pets for sale" ads in local newspapers and on website lost/found postings (craigslist, etc.).
- ▶ Post found pet signs in and around your neighborhood.
- ▶ Call your local veterinarian(s) to report a found pet and seek information on missing pets.
- ▶ Be sure to contact other shelters within your area.

LCAS wants every animal to make that important "phone call home."



Remember to Love, License and Spay/Neuter Your Pet!

Lost an Animal?

- ▶ Check with Lane County Animal Services immediately! LCAS is required to hold animals for 3 business days if your pet is without valid identification and 5 business days if your pet has valid I.D. If tags are not traceable, such as invalid address or disconnected phone number, your animal will be held 3 business days.
- ▶ Visit www.lanecounty.org/Animals to view currently impounded animals.
- ▶ Come to the impound kennels at 3970 West 1st Avenue in Eugene to search for a lost pet. We cannot tell you over the phone if your pet is at the shelter. We can check the dispatch log, found reports and dead animal file. While at the shelter, we will assist you in filling out a lost pet report.
- ▶ Check out “lost/found pets” and “pets for sale” ads in local newspapers and website lost/found postings (craigslist, etc.).
- ▶ Call your local veterinarian(s) about displaying information on a missing pet.
- ▶ Post lost pet signs in and around your neighborhood.
- ▶ Be sure to contact other shelters within your area.
