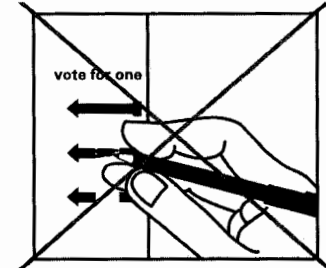
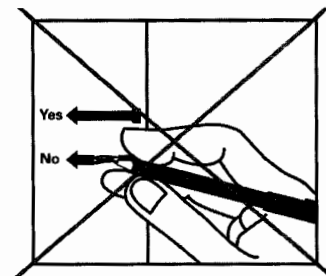
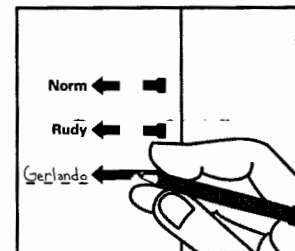
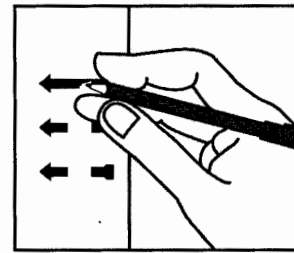


LANE COUNTY ELECTIONS VOTING SYSTEM INSTRUCTIONS

Mark Sense/Optical Scan System

STEP 1:

- Use a ballpoint pen (no gel pens, no markers, no red ink) to mark your ballot by drawing **ONLY one single line to connect the front and back of the arrow**. Only complete one arrow unless the choice listed below the contest indicates other than VOTE FOR ONE, or you will invalidate the contest by overvoting.
- To vote for a write-in candidate, write the name of the write-in candidate in the space marked "Write-In." You must draw a line connecting the head and tail of the arrow that points at the "Write-In" space for your write-in vote to be counted.
- Remember to inspect your ballot for mistakes. If you cannot or prefer not to correct your ballot as indicated below, you may call Lane County Elections to request a **REPLACEMENT BALLOT**.
- If you make a mistake while voting, write **ER** to the left of the arrow where the error occurred, and then vote your correct choice.
- If the contest indicates "Vote for Two" or more, make sure you did not complete arrows for more than the allowable amount.
- **DO NOT TEAR OFF ANY PORTION OF THE OFFICIAL BALLOT PAGE. THE FULL OFFICIAL BALLOT PAGE MUST BE RETURNED FOR COUNTING.**
- Some ballot styles may have contests or measures on both sides of the ballot. **BE SURE TO VOTE BOTH SIDES OF THE BALLOT IF APPLICABLE.**



STEP 2:

- Sign the voter's statement on the back of the Return Identification Envelope. Your ballot will NOT be counted if the envelope is not SIGNED.
- Place **YOUR** voted official paper ballot in the secrecy envelope and seal the envelope. The secrecy envelope is NOT REQUIRED, but the voted ballot must be returned in the **SEALED** Return Identification Envelope.
- Place the sealed secrecy envelope in the Return Identification Envelope and **SEAL** the Return Identification Envelope prior to mailing or delivering to an Official Drop Site location.
