WHEREAS, President Bush signed into law the Healthy Forests Restoration Act of 2003 to reduce the risk of catastrophic fire to communities, help save the lives of firefighters and citizens, and protect threatened and endangered species, and

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2004, the Board of County Commissioners approved development of a Community Wildfire Protection Plan for Lane County, and

WHEREAS, completion of a Community Wildfire Protection Plan will earn communities priority for funding of hazardous fuels reduction projects under the Healthy Forests Restoration Act of 2003, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has reviewed the draft of Lane County's Community Wildfire Protection Plan and found that the Plan reflects the intent of the Healthy Forests Restoration Act;

WHEREAS, pursuant to this resolution the Board of County Commissioners shall attempt and aspire to:

- a. Encourage communication between agencies and stakeholders about wildfire risk reduction strategies
- b. Provide leadership and actively partner with other agencies for implementing wildland-urban interface fire mitigation strategies in Lane County as appropriate and feasible;
- c. To assist with identifying and prioritizing community values that must be protected from wildfire;
- d. Increase fire safety education and awareness among communities and homeowners; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners hereby concurs with and adopts the Lane County Community Wildfire Protection Plan (June 2005) attached hereto and incorporated by this reference
