Site Improvements Cause Closure at Transfer Sites Week of November 15th.

Lane County Public Works is making improvements at two local transfer sites.

Work is underway at Rattlesnake and Veneta transfer sites where the deck height at both sites is being raised approximately 2 feet to improve customers' access to transfer trailers.

While most of the work will happen during days the site is normally closed, there will be some impact to the site until the work is completed.

"We'll be able to keep the sites open during part of the work, but we will need to close the sites during the actual paving," said Jeff Bishop, Waste Management superintendent. "We hope to keep the impact to the community limited."

Public Works staff has been handing out fliers at each site to inform customers of the project.

Rattlesnake Transfer Site

- **Wednesday, November 10:** Site is open and customers will have access to one waste trailer only while work continues.
- **Thursday, November 11:** Site closed for Veterans Day.
- **Friday, November 12 and Saturday, November 13:** Site open; access to one waste trailer only.
- **Monday, November 15 and Tuesday, November 16:** Site closed as usual; paving work in progress (weather permitting).
- **Wednesday, November 17:** Project completed; site open; access to both trailers.

Veneta Transfer Site

- **Monday, November 15:** Site is closed for construction.
- **Tuesday, November 16:** Site is closed for construction.
- **Wednesday, November 17:** Site is closed for construction.
- **Thursday, November 18:** Site is closed for construction.
- **Friday, November 19 and Saturday, November 20:** Site open; access to one waste trailer only.
- **Monday, November 22 and Tuesday, November 23:** Site closed; paving work in progress (weather permitting).
- **Wednesday, November 24:** Site reopens with access to both trailers.
