DETAILS:

On November 3, at approximately 6:36 P.M., Lane County Sheriff's deputies responded to a vehicle versus pedestrian crash at 30th Avenue, just west of Eldon Schafer. Upon arrival, deputies discovered that a 57 year old Eugene woman was struck by two vehicles while crossing 30th Avenue.

The victim was first struck by a white Honda Civic, and then subsequently struck by a black Pontiac Fiero, following the Honda. The victim died at the scene; however, no one else was injured in the crash. Neither alcohol nor speed appear to be factors in the crash.

The crash remains under investigation by the Lane County Sheriff's Office Traffic and Life Safety Team. There were no arrests made or citations issued, however the investigation will be reviewed by the Lane County District Attorney's Office. The victim's identity was not released pending notification of next of kin.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Lane County Sheriff's Office has positively identified the women struck by two motor vehicles on 30th Avenue just west of Eldon Schafer.
