



Lane County Sheriff's Amateur Radio Operators (LCSARO)



LCSARO is a volunteer group that assists the Lane County Sheriff's Office in emergency situations. Using amateur radio, the LCSARO group is able to supplement and/or replace overloaded telephone operations until phone service is restored.

Requirements for LCSARO members are they must be licensed by the Federal Communications Commission and have their own operating amateur radio equipment. There is no cost involved with being a member other than the cost of your gas to get to and from the monthly training exercises.
